As I write this article, today (April 15th ) is Jackie Robinson Day around Major League Baseball. This special day is a time to celebrate Jackie

Robinson's start with the Brooklyn Dodgers as the first African American in modern baseball. To commemorate the day, all MLB players will wear the number 42, Jackie's number. I've been reading the book 42 Faith: The Rest of the Jackie Robinson Story, about the faith of Robinson and others in his orbit like Dodgers GM Branch Rickey.

One of the stories of theological import recounted in the book was dramatized in the movie 42 (2013). This story includes Dodger star shortstop Pee Wee Reese and Jackie Robinson warming up in the field before a batter. That day, the Cincinnati crowd was screaming hurtful words at Jackie, a black man in a white man's sport. Reese went up to Robinson and placed his arm around Robinson, and after a little banter, the movie portrays Reese as saying: "Maybe tomorrow we'll all wear 42. That way they won't tell us apart."

While historians debate where and when this event may or may not have happened, this scene in the movie reminded me of Paul's words in Galatians 3:26-29. Reese's words point to looking beyond what divides us.

Paul's words reminded the Galatians that faith in Christ unites all believers (v. 26). The congregation (s) to whom Paul was writing had been divided between the Gentile Christians and the Jewish Christians. Paul goes a step further by stating that Christ unites and negates some of the labels that divide us: There is no longer Jew or Gentile, slave or free, male and female. For you are all one in Christ Jesus. (Gal 3:28 NLT). Sadly, Christians are divided in many ways, e.g. denominations, color, worship preferences, etc. Christians should take to heart the words of Lutheran theologian Rupertus Meldenius (d. 1651): *In necessariis unitas, in non-necessariis libertas, in omnibus caritas* [In the necessities, unity; in the non-essentials, freedom; and in everything, **charity**].


